## Call for bids to organize the 9<sup>th</sup> World Congress of Biomechanics in 2022

The World Council of Biomechanics is inviting bids to organize the 9<sup>th</sup> World Congress of Biomechanics, which will take place in 2022 (usually June-August). While it is customary for the congress to rotate between America, Europe and Asia/Oceania, bids will be accepted from all locations.

The bid, should follow the format for hosting a large<sup>1</sup> scientific meeting and must include information regarding the following points:

- Leadership team
- National scientific organizations
- Institutional support
- Financial support and provisional budget
- Registration fees with specific conditions for students,
- Conference facilities (Plenary sessions, sessions)
- Housing and transportation facilities
- Social program options.

The bid must be presented by a group headed by one or more academic senior scientists active in the field of biomechanics or by a national biomechanics society, headed by its President.

It is recommended to involve the members of World Council of Biomechanics in the organization process. Specifically, we encourage the participation of at least one member of the Council executive committee to the organizing committee of the Congress. The Council will vote late 2016 or early 2017 to select the organization that will be invited to organize World Congress.

The World Council may make available upon request a refundable grant to the Congress organization (amount depending on availability of funds), but is not financially responsible for the event: this is the responsibility of the host organization.
